Special Board Meeting
February 26, 2009

Thank you madam chair for the opportunity to speak.

Let me make it perfectly clear that I am speaking on behalf of the district in my official role as the DM. I am not speaking on behalf of the board of directors or any individual member of the board nor any of members of our community.

I am not seeking any response nor will I respond to any questions after my statement has been completed.

On February 23rd, 2009 Mr. Ron Pace called Mountain States Employment Council and ask that the manager return his call to discuss an urgent matter the telephone number left was 719-553-6573 and I recognize that number as one that is used by Mr. Pace.

Mr. Pace when question by the manager, Nikki Aggers, as to whether or not he was a legal representative of the District neither denied nor confirmed that was. By his silence to the question he implied that in fact he was a representative of the district. When Mr. Pace ask for information, that he already possessed from the district, invoices and the draft salary survey, he indicated that he wanted it sent to a particular e-mail address. When the manager did not recognize the address as an official e-mail address of the district she then informed Mr. Pace that an e-mail address containing the words "springhollow" was not an official e-mail address of the district, he instructed Nikki to send the information to Director Jennifer Marie Barber's e-mail address with or without director Barber's permission. If it was without Director Barber's permission and since this is her private and personal e-mail address he violated her privacy which is punishable if director Barber wishes to pursue the issue. Impersonating, by implication, or otherwise, a public employee is a class 6 felony misdemeanor in the state of Colorado.

Furthermore, Mr. Pace your first amendment rights under the Constitution of the United States do not give you the right to maliciously and with forethought place statements in your e-mails, on your website that are grossly misleading and patently false to make your point. Your constant barrage of false claims, requests under the open records act, which from time to time you have refused delivery of the very items that you requested, tirades, website postings, calling the district legal firm has cost this community an additional \$10,500.00 in legal fees since October of 2008 and I see by your website that you have even falsified this fact to your own end.

Mr. Pace, this district, nor the covenants board is suing anyone. Four members of this community have filed a lawsuit against the district and covenants board and we are simply defending in this lawsuit. Your gross misrepresentation of the cost of this lawsuit can be construed as an intent to incite.

Mr. Pace, you and Mr. Burgess and other members of the recall committee, which Mr. Burgess is purportedly the spokesperson as announced in the last board meeting are continuing through to this day to blackmail a member of this board with threatening recall to force this board member to bow to

your demands and again burdening this community with an additional cost of six to ten thousand dollars for such an election. Blackmail is also a criminal offense.

I am now issuing an ultimatum to you. You have until 12:00 noon tomorrow, Friday February 27, 2009 to retract your false statements from your public website and post the facts accurately or I will turn everything that I have accumulated concerning you and your actions to the district attorney for prosecution.

I am not interested in seeing another flurry of e-mails from you ranting and raving about how you feel your rights have been trampled. I do not want see a single e-mail that contains any false information or how you are constantly being threatened or how you are a poor disabled vet. The ADA has nothing to do with this. Your personal behavior is the direct result of these consequences.


I do not wish to hear from Mr. Burgess or Mr. Chin regarding any of these issues. You three individuals have caused harm to our community by interfering with the conduct of business of this district and which could very well result in a failed bond renegotiation that will cost our community 1.6 million dollars.

I simply want what is best for our community and for this board of directors to conduct the business of the district without fear of threats and retaliation.

I am tired of listening to the same old rhetoric in every scheduled board meeting. Enough is enough. This district and our community is facing huge issues in water and wastewater and we must move forward to resolve those issues or face the possibility that our homes here will be absolutely worthless in five years or less.

I find it frustrating and exasperating that we are still discussing issues that were presented to this board in August of 2008 namely trucks. It is absolutely amazing that we now have a board member researching this issue once again, this is a responsibility of the DM. I understand that Mr. Burgess was appointed to construct an organizational chart for the district, again a function of the DM. Did anyone bother to ask the DM if a chart existed? By the way it does!

In conclusion, as the DM, it is my responsibility to continually work in the best interest of our community and to carry out the policies and directives from the board of directors. I am not at the beck and call of Mr. Pace or any other single member of the community. From this point forward I am refusing to let Mr. Pace or any other resident disrupt, slow down or impair my ability to act in my official capacity.
